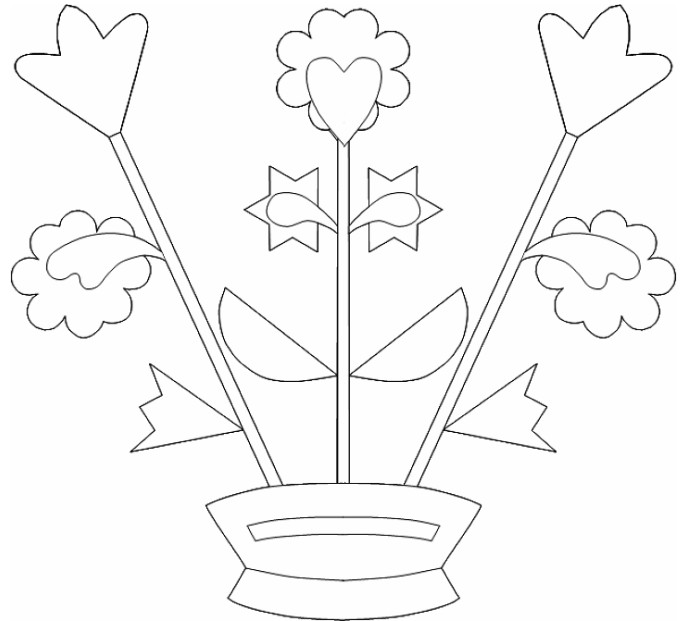

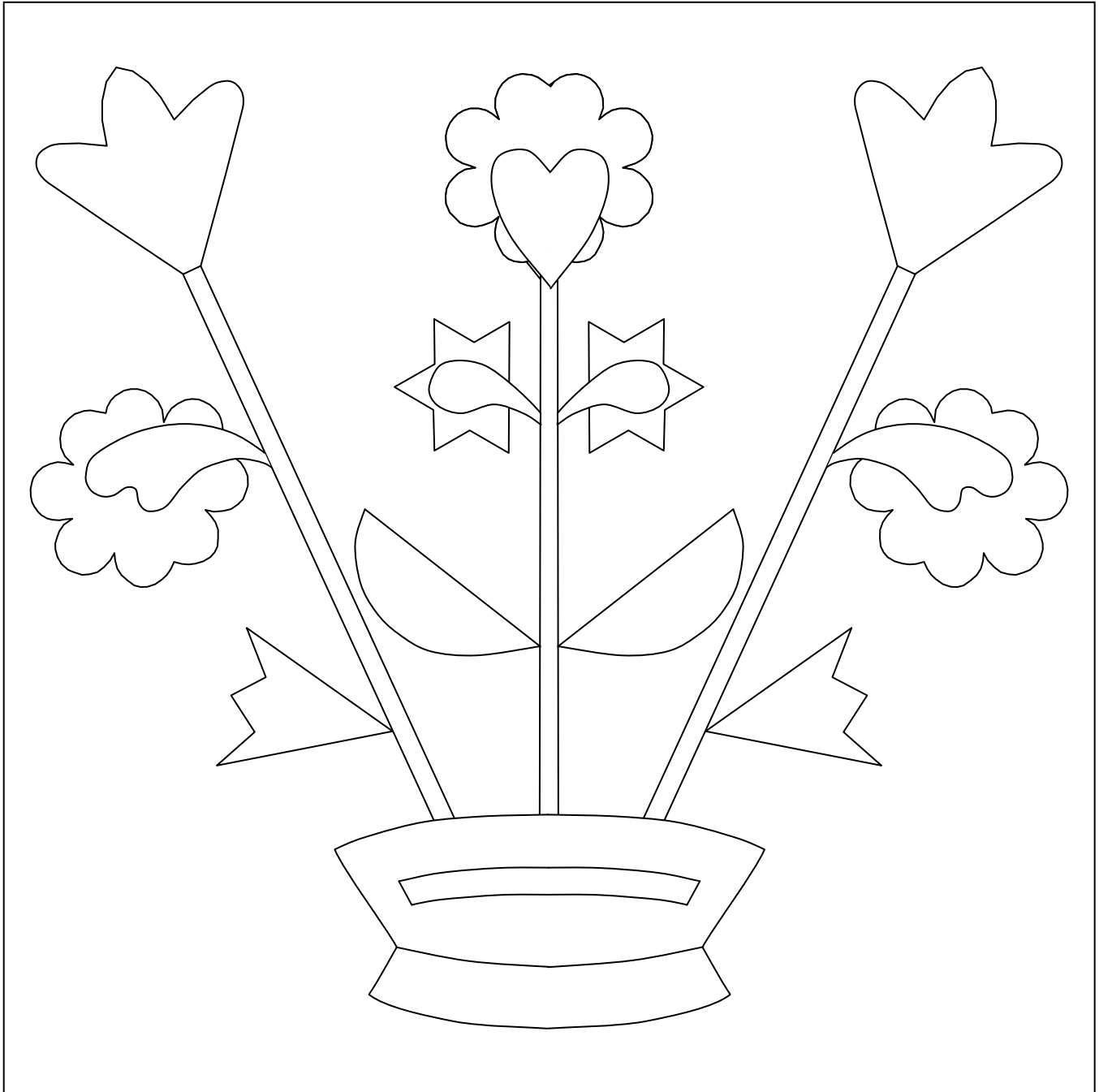

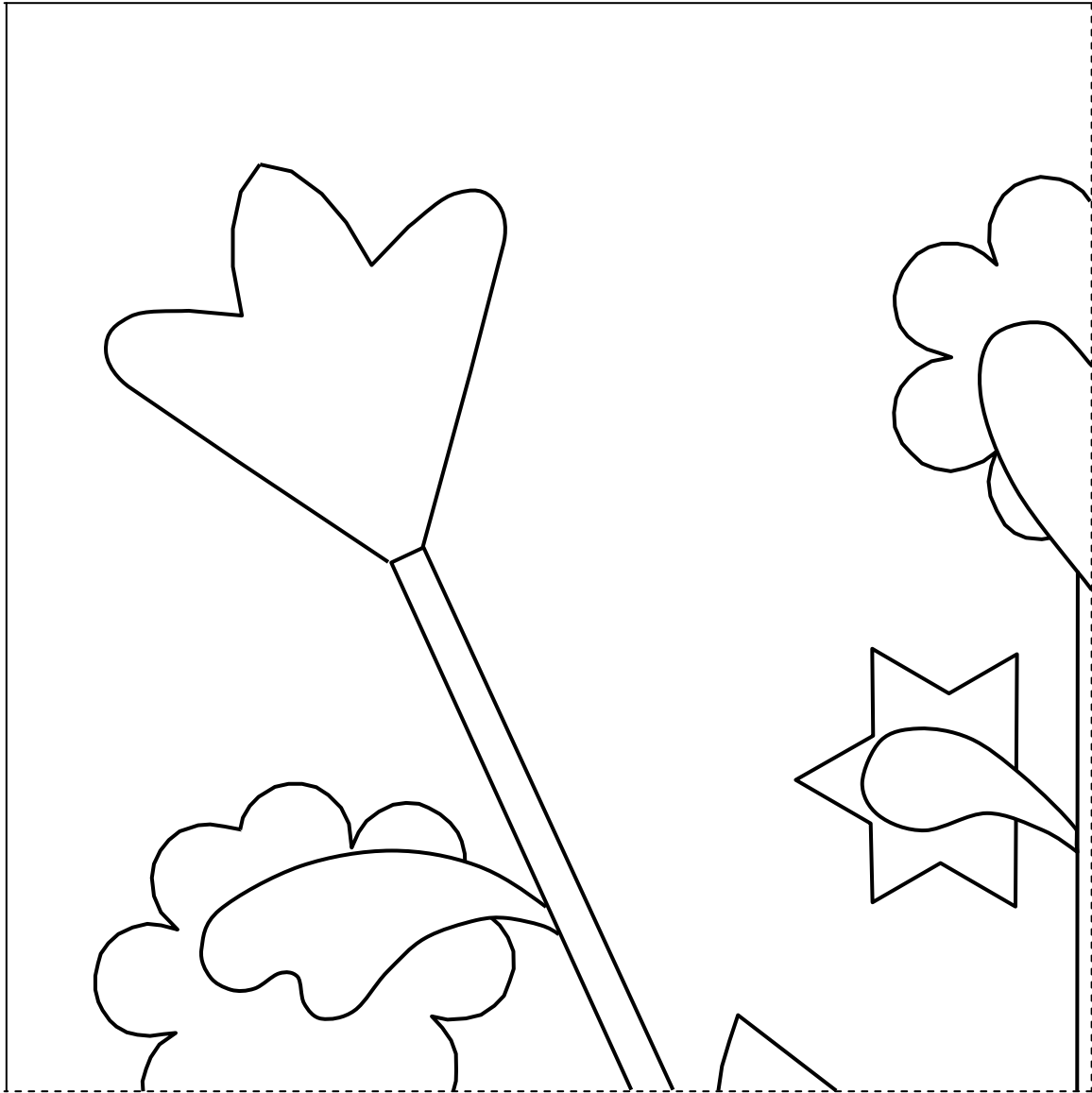

Elizabeth Neff Block (full pattern, reduced)



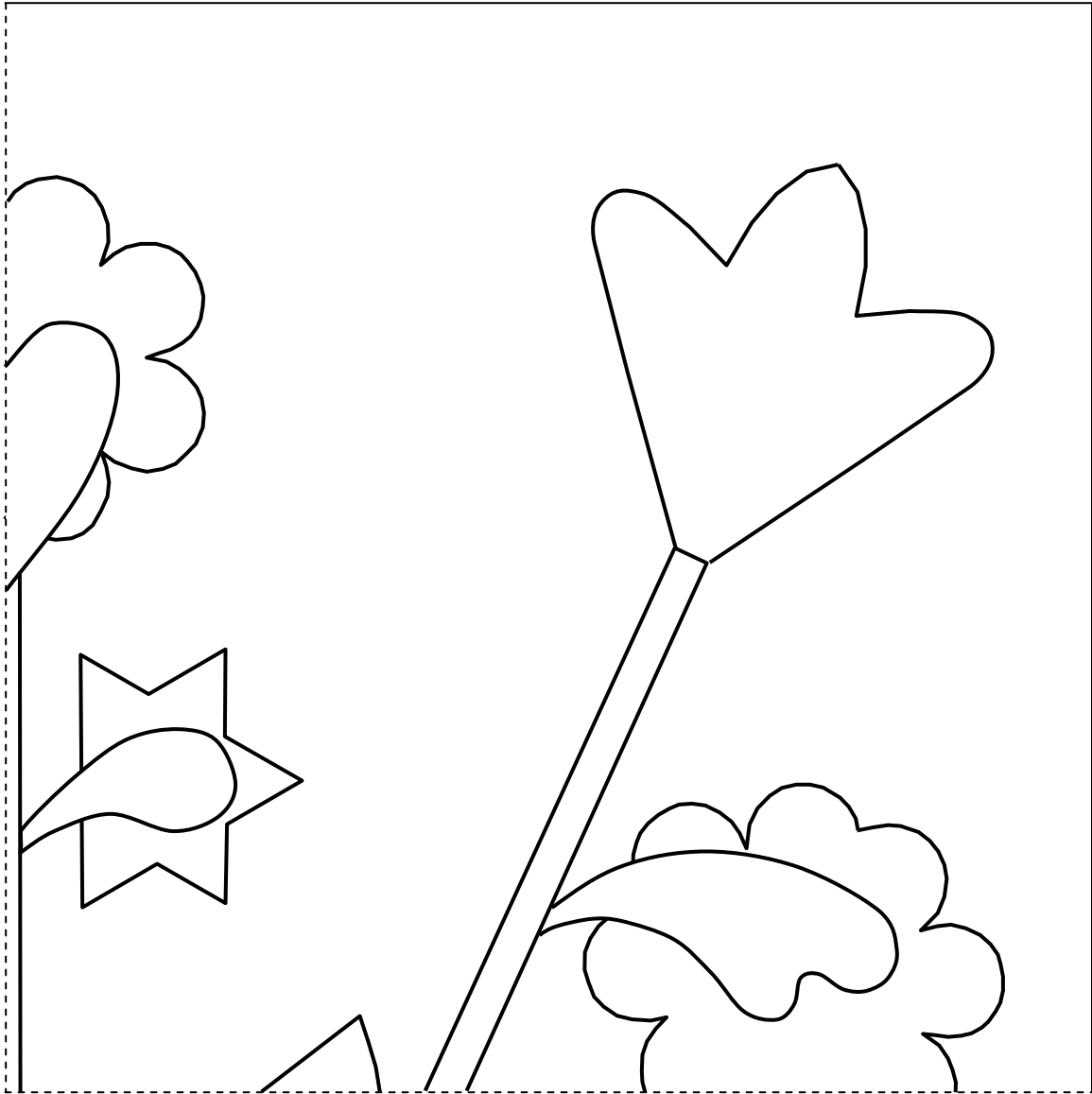

Elizabeth Neff Block (upper left)



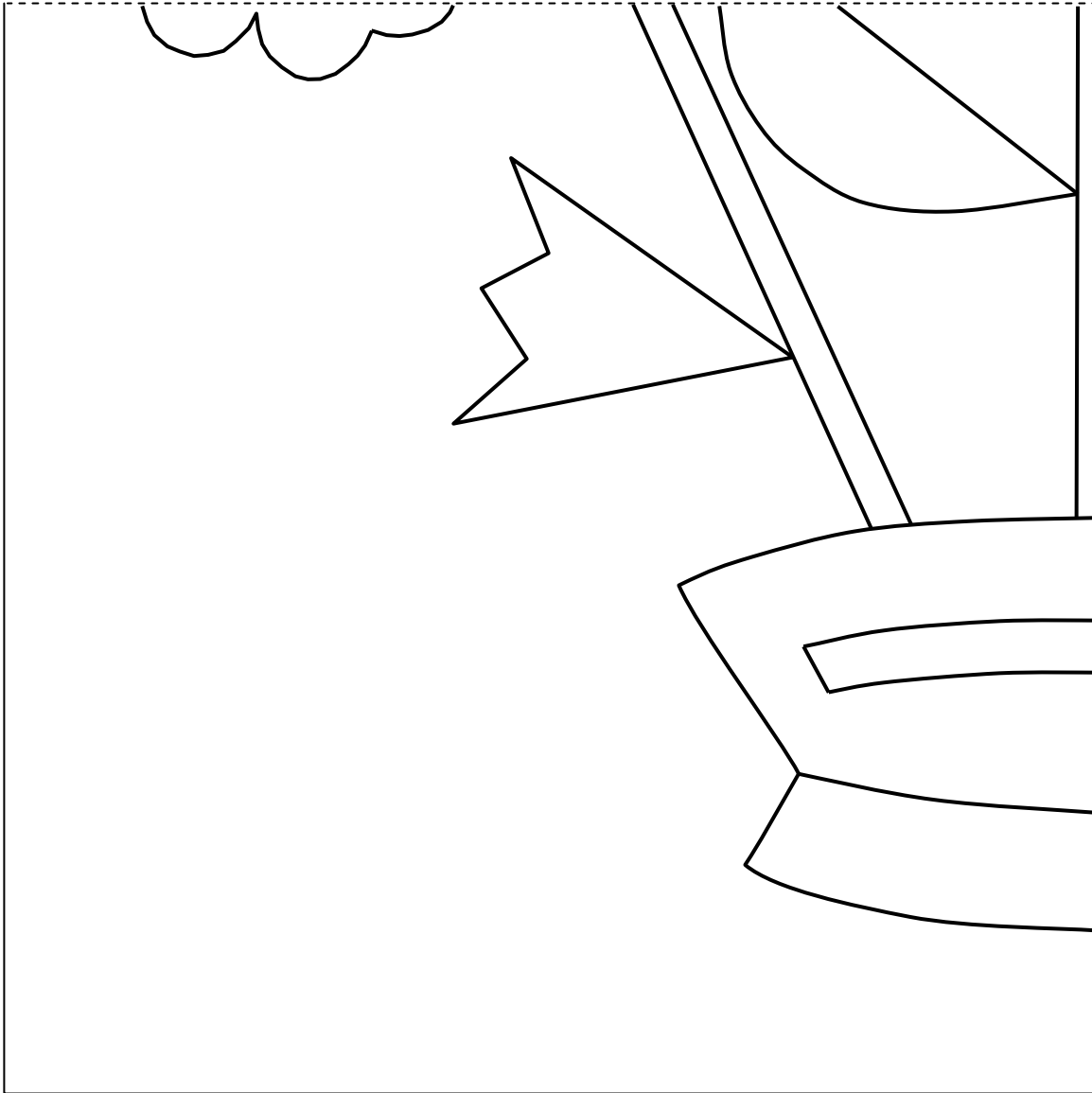
